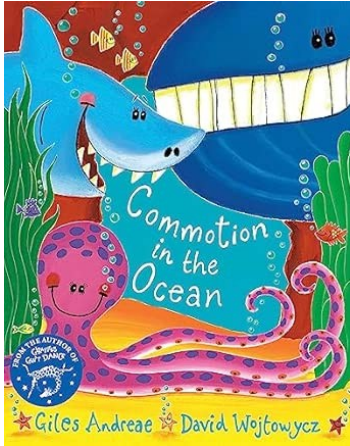

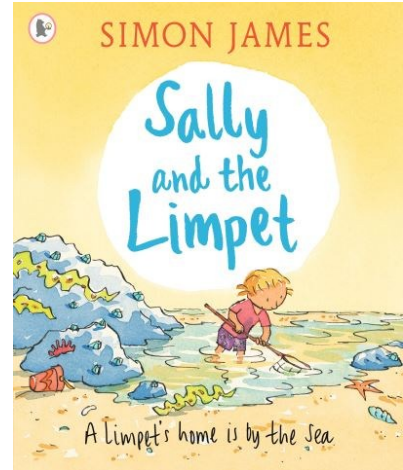
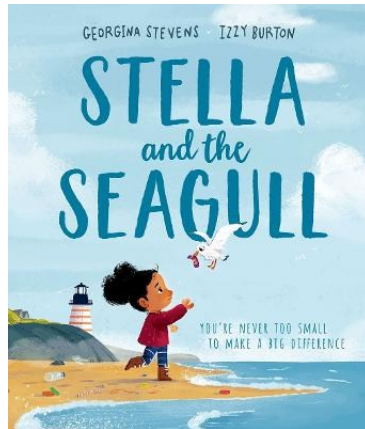
Dive into the ocean for a noisy, rhyming animal adventure in this colourful read-aloud picture book!

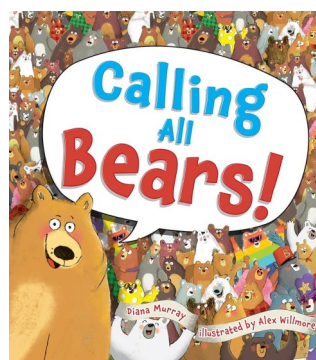
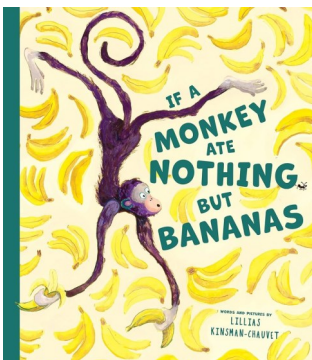
Sally and the Limpet
