Key Skills

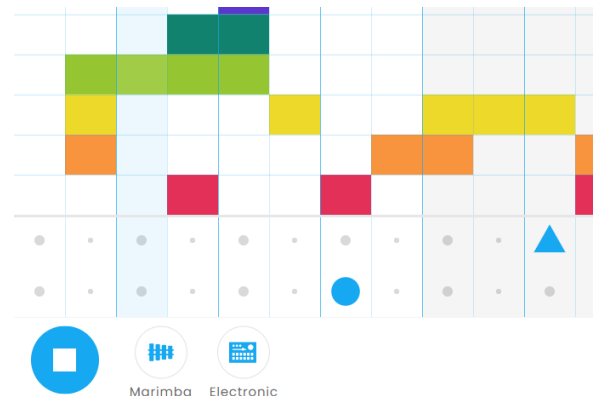
- Identify simple differences in pieces of music.

Key Vocabulary

Rhythm – A strong, regular repeated pattern of movement or sound.

Pitch – How high or low the note sounds.

Melody – A collection of musical tones that are grouped together.

Command - A single instruction that can be used in a program to control a computer.

Program - A set of ordered commands that can be run by a computer to complete a task.
