### Concepts:

#### Values and commitments

Understanding how individuals develop a sense of identity and belonging through faith or belief. Exploring the variety, difference and relationships that exist within and between religions, values and beliefs.

Church	Christian place of worship.
Noah	Well-known for building an ark that preserved himself and his family, as well as representatives of every land animal, from a great flood that God unleashed in judgment upon the earth.
Covenant	An agreement.
Baptism	Rite of initiation involving sprinkling with or immersion in water.
Wedding	Rite where people are united and make promises to each other.

To make clear links between the story of Noah and the idea of covenant.

To make simple links between promises in the story of Noah and promises that Christians make at a wedding ceremony.

To make links between the story of Noah and how we live in school and the wider world.
