<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <p><u>Catch-up priorities</u></p> <p>Continue to deliver a full curriculum for the school year 2023 - 2024</p> <p>Ensure fluency of key skills and understanding are embedded through small group support to ensure as many pupils are working at age-related expectations</p> <p><u>Core approaches</u></p> <p>To continue to teach all subjects and have a regular school timetable, with the day starting at 8.35 am and finishing at 3.20pm</p> <p>Communal areas and additional space is prioritised (halls, meetings rooms and library) for Y2-Y6 interventions</p> <p>One academic mentor is aligned to UPKS2 year group and deployed based on identified gaps in learning.</p> <p>All year groups use regular low-stakes quizzes to identify gaps in learning and impact and summative question level analysis.</p> <p>Interventions directed by year group leaders and class teachers. Flexibility based on the needs and the gaps of learning of targeted pupils</p> <p>Deployment of academic mentor is supported by one of the assistant headteachers</p> <p>CPD as well as monitoring to ensure interventions have an impact on pupil's outcomes</p> <p>Lexia being used for SEND pupils in the classroom</p> <p><u>The overall aims of our catch-up premium strategy:</u></p> <p>To reduce the attainment gap between our disadvantaged pupils and their peers</p> <p>To raise the attainment of all pupils to close the gap created by COVID-19 school closures</p>
