Key Enquiry Question: Who made the world?

Religion: Christianity

Concepts:

Beliefs, teachings and sources

Interpreting teachings, sources, authorities and ways of life in order to understand religions and beliefs.

Exploring the impact of religions and beliefs on how people live their lives.

Key Vocabulary

Creation Story	The story of how God created the world in 7 days.
Creator	The spirit, God, who created the world.
Adam	The first man that God created.
Eve	The first woman that God created.
Bible	A book made from a collection of stories that is sacred to Christians. They believe that it was written from God's words.
Genesis	The beginning of how the world was created.

RE Skills

To retell the story of creation from Genesis 1:1 – 2.3 simply.

To recognise that 'Creation' is the beginning of the 'big story' of the Bible.

To say what the story tells Christians about God, Creation and the world.

To give at least one example of what Christians do to say thank you to God for the Creation.

To think, talk and ask questions about living in an amazing world.
