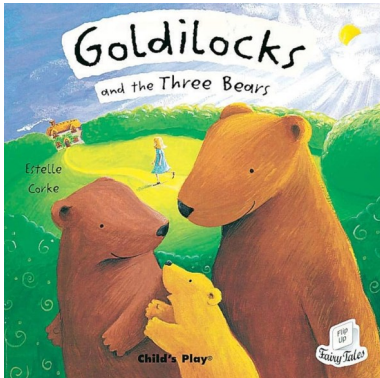

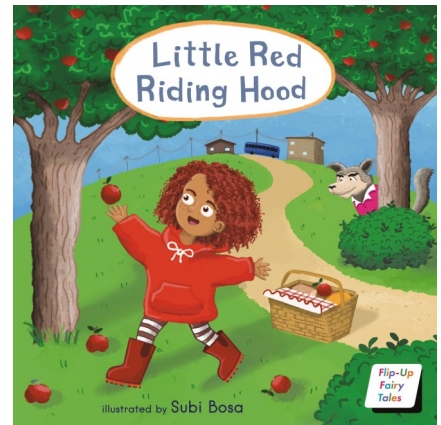
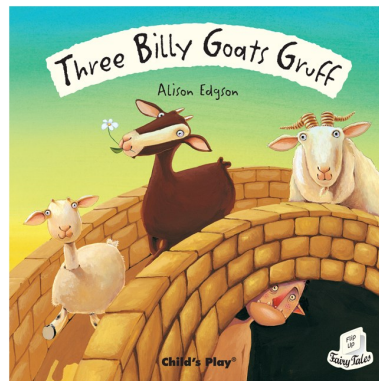

Can the billy goats make it over the bridge before being captured by the troll?



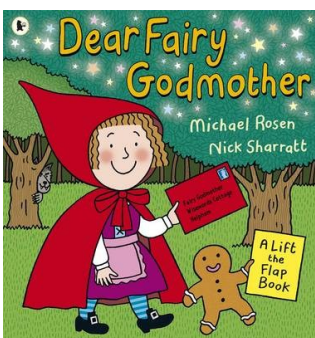
Goldilocks and the Three Bears
