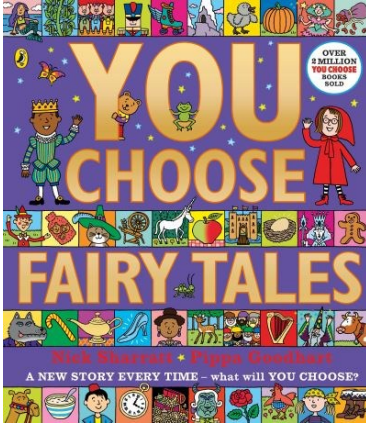

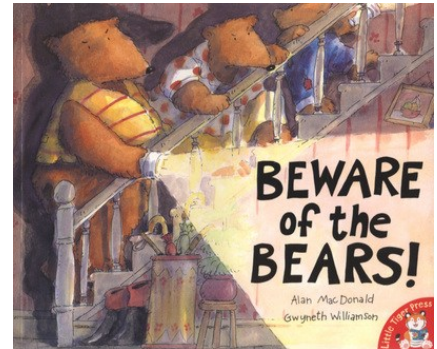
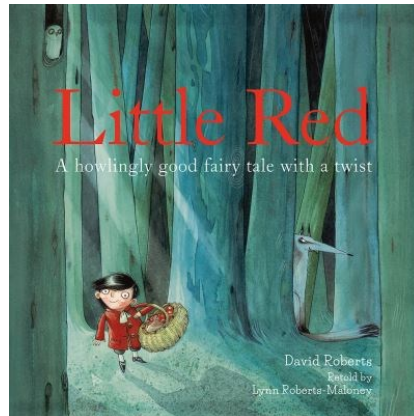
You Choose: Fairy Tales

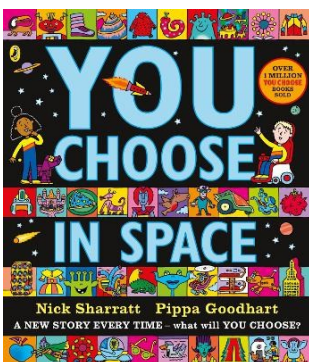


Beware of the Bears

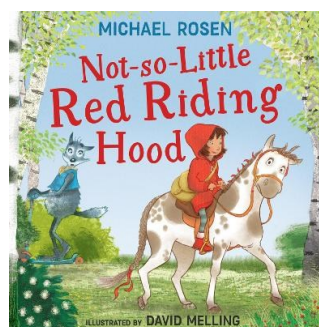
