## **9<sup>th</sup> September 2025**

## **16<sup>th</sup> September 2025**

## **23<sup>rd</sup> September 2025**

Discussed upcoming events - LG organised with Handsworth food bank to make a donation in October. (poster to go out next week)

Non-uniform day for Snowflake appeal at the end of term.

Discussed future fundraising ideas e.g. adopt a bear/cake sale.

## **29<sup>th</sup> September 2025**

Tuck shop - issues with helpers not turning up and rubbish is being left. Student councillors to read out a list of expectations.

Handsworth Foodbank posters given out to share with classes and a notice went in the newsletter last week. Information about snowflake to go in the newsletter this week.

### **17<sup>th</sup> October 2025**

All jumpers/cardigans arrived and councillors are wearing them.

Tuck shop - few tweaks to rota due to children not turning up but the running of tuck shop all good after reminders last week.

Classes to have reminders about Handsworth Foodbank donations - student councillor to check their posters is displayed in their classroom. Poster given out to each class about snowflake and non-uniform day to fundraise.

### **14<sup>th</sup> October 2025**

Last reminder about Handsworth Foodbank donations - collection happening on the 22nd. Promote art competition in classes.

Explained we have signed up for Junior Road Safety Officers - JRSO (Y6 to lead). Pack should be arriving this week.

Ideas for CIN:
