**Key Enquiry Question:** Was Jesus the Messiah?

**Concept:**

Expressing meaning

Appreciating that individuals and cultures express their beliefs and values through many different forms.

Ethical, spiritual, philosophical challenges

Exploring some of the ultimate questions that confront humanity, and responding imaginatively to them.

### Key Vocabulary

Messiah	The anointed one.
Saviour	A person who saves someone or something from danger or difficulty (in Christianity) God or Jesus Christ as the redeemer of sin and saver of souls.
Incarnation	The traditional Christian belief that God came into the world in human flesh in the person of Jesus Christ.
Advent	The period of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ at Christmas.
Bible	The Christian scriptures: consisting of the Old and New Testaments.

### RE Skills

Explain the place of Incarnation and Messiah within the 'big story' of the Bible.

Identify Gospel and prophecy texts, using technical terms. Explain connections between biblical texts, Incarnation and Messiah, using theological terms.

Show how Christians put their beliefs about Jesus' Incarnation into practice in different ways in celebrating Christmas.

Comment on how the idea that Jesus is the Messiah makes sense in the wider story of the Bible.

Weigh up how far the idea that Jesus is the Messiah — a Saviour from God — is important in the world today and, if it is true, what difference that might make in people's lives.
