

D&T – Textiles: Combining Different Fabric Shapes

Key Vocabulary

Mock up – quick 3-D modelling using easy to work and cheaper materials and temporary joints. Useful for checking proportions and scale.

Pattern or template – a shape drawn to exact shape and size, used to assist in cutting out.

Seam allowance – extra fabric allowed for joining together - 15mm for domestic patterns.

Specification – describes what a product has to do.

Tacking – large running stitches to hold pieces of fabric together temporarily.

Working drawing – detailed drawing contains all information needed to make a product but is updated as changes are made.

Wadding - soft, thick material used to line garments or pack fragile items, especially cotton wool formed into a fleecy layer.

Hem - the edge of a piece of cloth or clothing which has been turned under and sewn.

Authentic - of undisputed origin and not a copy; genuine.

Key Questions

- How can CAD help me with my design ideas?
- What methods of joining the fabric would be most effective?
- How do the textiles used match the intended purpose?
- What components have been used to enhance the appearance?
- How has my design succeeded in meeting the needs of the user?



Key Skills
