Key Enquiry Question: Why does Easter matter to Christians?

Religion: Christianity

Concepts:

Salvation

Christian's relationship with God and needing to find peace and freedom.

Practices and ways of life

Exploring the impact of religions and beliefs on how people live their lives.

Understanding that religious practices are diverse, change over time and are influenced by cultures.

Key Vocabulary

Easter	A Christian festival remembering the resurrection of Jesus from the dead.
Holy Week	The week before Easter which includes Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.
resurrection	The rising of Christ from the dead.
Easter egg	Represent Jesus' appearance from the tomb and resurrection.
hot cross bun	Symbolise the crucifixion of Jesus on Good Friday on the cross.

RE Skills

Tell stories of Holy Week and Easter from the Bible and recognise a link with the idea of Salvation (Jesus rescuing people).

Recognise that Jesus gives instructions about how to behave.

Give at least three examples of how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus' death and resurrection in church worship at Easter.

Think, talk and ask questions about whether the story of Easter has anything to say to them about sadness, hope or heaven, exploring different ideas.
