Information Technology

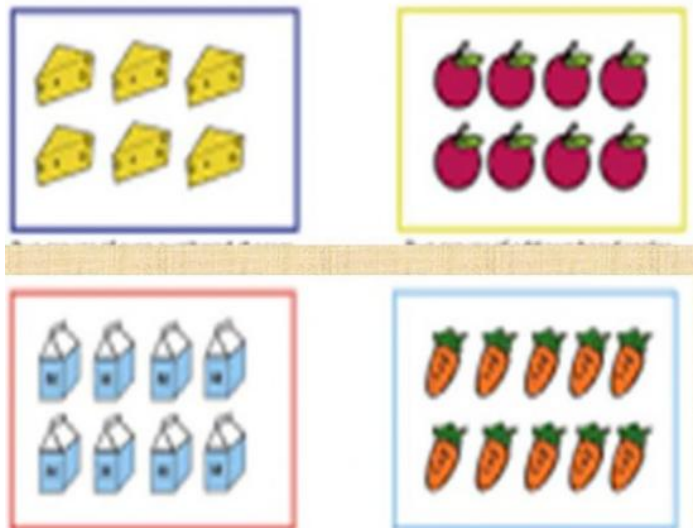
Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

Key Vocabulary

Data - A letter, word, number etc. that has been collected for a purpose, but stored without context.

Information - Data put into a context that provides meaning.

Labels - Assign to a category.

Sort - The arrangement of data in a prescribed sequence.

Properties - Attributes that are associated with something.
