**Theme:** Salvation

**Key Enquiry Question:** What difference does the resurrection make to Christians?

**Religion:** Christianity

**Concepts:**

Salvation

Christian's relationship with God and needing to find peace and freedom.

Identity, diversity and belonging

Understanding how individuals develop a sense of identity and belonging through faith or belief.

Exploring the variety, difference and relationships that exist within and between religions, values and beliefs.

### Key Vocabulary

Holy Week	The week before Easter which includes Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.
resurrection	The rising of Christ from the dead.
sacrifice	God and Jesus both give the ultimate sacrifice for the benefit of others, for our benefit.
crucifixion	Tied or nailed to a large wooden cross.
Good Friday	Catholics commemorate the crucifixion of Jesus Christ. It is also a legal holiday around much of the world.

### RE Skills

Suggest meanings for resurrection accounts, and compare their ideas with ways in which Christians interpret these texts, showing awareness of the centrality of the Christian belief in Resurrection.

Make clear connections between Christian belief in the Resurrection and how Christians worship on Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

Show how Christians put their beliefs into practice in different ways. Explain why some people find belief in the Resurrection makes sense and inspires them.

Offer and justify their own responses as to what difference belief in Resurrection might make to how people respond to challenges and problems in the world today.
