Akhirah	Everlasting life after death in Islam.
Muhammad	Muslims believe in one God, Allah, and follow the teachings of the Prophet Muhammad, Allah's messenger.
Qur'an	The central religious text of Islam.
Five pillars	The Five Pillars of Islam are some basic acts in Islam, considered mandatory by believers, and are the foundation of Muslim life.
Jihad	Arabic word which literally means striving or struggling.
Ummah	Arabic word meaning "community".
