### **Y6 Crucial Crew Visit**

Children in Y6 will be taking part in Crucial Crew, an educational event delivered in partnership with Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council and local emergency and support services. This will take place at The Lifewise Centre in Rotherham on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2026.

Crucial Crew is designed to support young people in developing the knowledge and skills they need to stay safe and make positive choices as they grow older. Throughout the event, students will take part in a range of interactive workshops led by professionals from different services.

The sessions will cover important real-life topics, including:

- Personal safety and decision-making
- Road and transport safety
- Fire safety
- First aid and emergency situations
- Substance awareness
- Online safety
- Community safety and consequences of risky behaviour

The aim of Crucial Crew is to help students build confidence, responsibility, and awareness, enabling them to better understand risks and know how to respond appropriately in real-life situations.

This is a valuable and well-established programme that supports our wider PSHE and safeguarding curriculum. Students will be supervised at all times, and the content will be delivered in an age-appropriate and engaging manner.

Your child will need to wear their school uniform as normal and sensible footwear.

Your child will need a packed lunch in line with our packed lunch policy (e.g. no juice or fizzy drinks etc). If your child is entitled to receive income based free school meals and you would like school to provide your child with a packed lunch, please indicate this on the Google Form. Please note, this will be a cheese sandwich grab bag.

We will leave school promptly at 8.55am, therefore your child needs to arrive at school no later than 8.40am, and are due to arrive back at school for 3.10pm. If this is likely to change, we will send a message via "The SchoolApp".

When making payments on ParentPay, we would recommend that Parents/Carers **do not** use the 'One Click Payment' option and instead add the payment item to the basket and checkout using a debit card as you would with any online shopping. This is because the 'One Click Payment' can take up to seven days for ParentPay to attempt to take the payment from bank accounts, which we have found do sometimes fail.
